On June 20, 2016, BlueEarth Renewables (BluEarth) requested the consent of the Minister of Environment to transfer the Environmental Assessment Certificate (Certificate) E13-04 for the Narrows Inlet Hydro Project (Narrows Inlet) to Tems Sayamkwu General Partnership Corp (Tems Sayamkwu).
